



Night Shift Workers Travel Registration

Dear Tyne Pedestrian and Cyclist Tunnel User

As you will know, the Tyne Pedestrian and Cyclist Tunnels between Howdon and Jarrow are closed for refurbishment.

A free, timetabled replacement shuttle bus service is operating between 6am and 8pm, seven days a week, to accommodate both pedestrians and cyclists wishing to travel across the river.

We have also considered how we can help night shift workers **with no other means** of transport to cross the river outside of these hours.

A free, night shuttle is operating for registered pedestrians and cyclists with pick-ups on the South at Tyne Street, Jarrow and on the North at Tyne View Terrace, Howdon.

Those wishing to register their interest in this service should review the following statements:
